

18. USE OF AINDT LOGO AND REFERENCE TO THE NAME AINDT.

1. Introduction

- 1.1. The following sets out the conditions for the use of the AINDT logo and reference to the name AINDT in published material other than that produced by AINDT, including letterheads, business cards, insignia and other documented material not directly associated with the activities of the AINDT or the AINDT Certification Board.
- 1.2. Without exception, the use of the AINDT logo and other insignia for purposes other than for official AINDT business shall require the full approval of the Federal Council or the Federal Executive.
- 1.3. Holders of AINDT Certification shall not use any other form of identification other than that provided by the AINDT Certification Board.
- 1.4. These requirements are effective from the date of the document below or the date of any subsequent revision of this document recorded in the Operations and Quality Manual.

2. Definitions

- 2.1. AINDT Logo: The mark shown in Figure 1 is the official mark used on all letterheads and material relating to the Institute.

- 2.2. Certification Body Accreditation: The identification card shown in Figure 2 indicates the level and the specific industry sectors that the person is certificated to and is the only means of displaying this information, and should be used for identification purposes when carrying out non-destructive testing for clients.

3. Form and display of the AINDT Logo.

- 3.1. The AINDT logo can only be used in the form shown in Figure 1. If used in larger or smaller size then the proportion of the dimensions shall remain the same.
- 3.2. The colours of the logo shall remain unaltered. i.e., the colour for the blue in the logo shall be P.M.S 308 and for the yellow P.M.S 136.
- 3.3. The logo can be used in conjunction with other logos in situations where logos of multiple sponsors may be displayed for conferences, exhibitions or other purposes that shall be determined.
- 3.4. The logo can be used for joint purposes such as memorandum of understandings between AINDT and similar organisations. Each logo must not be shown with any more prominence than the other.
- 3.5. Embossed, relief or stamped versions of the logo must not be used without prior permission of AINDT.
- 3.6. Organisations authorised by AINDT to use the logo will be provided with a master copy by the Federal Secretariat.
- 3.7. A register of approved organisations will be kept by the Federal Secretariat.

4. Use of the AINDT logo and reference to the name AINDT.

- 4.1. In accordance with the [Memorandum and Articles of Association](#) no person or organisation, for purposes of advancement or gain, shall append to his or her name, any abbreviation or initials to signify that that person is a member of AINDT. This includes promotional material such as brochures, business cards and stationary.
- 4.2. Officers of the Institute who are undertaking business related to Institute activities are entitled to use business cards supplied for this purpose by the Federal Secretariat.
- 4.3. May be used on stationary and material (excluding labels, documents or written announcements, affixed to, or appearing on goods or products that would indicate support by the Institute for such items).
- 4.4. May be used only by financial corporate members of the Institute to signify that they are members of AINDT on stationary, or any other documentation approved by Federal Council or the Federal Executive, in accordance with the Memorandum of Articles of Association.
- 4.5. On ceasing being a financial member of the Institute the corporate member will be required to withdraw all material containing reference to AINDT, or use of its logo, within a period of six months after becoming non-financial.

- 4.6. Approved organisations such as Authorised Qualifying Bodies and Examination Bodies may use the AINDT logo, and reference to the AINDT Certification Scheme in publicity material providing it is approved as per the Memorandum of Articles of Association.
- 4.7. Where the AINDT logo is used with accompanying text it must be clearly separated from other services offered by the AINDT Authorised Qualifying Body or Examination Body, which is not reflected in the scope of their authorisation. E.g. Linking the AINDT logo with other services provided by that organisation such as training or sales of goods or equipment.
- 4.8. The AINDT logo shall not be displayed on a product or test item and used to imply any aspect of product certification by AINDT.
- 4.9. The AINDT logo, or any reference to AINDT, shall not be used in such a way as to imply that AINDT accepts any responsibility for the accuracy of tests conducted by any certificated personnel or organisation.

5. Restrictions on use of the AINDT Logo or reference to AINDT

5.1 The logo or reference to AINDT is prohibited on: -

- 5.1.1. Vehicles.
- 5.1.2. Buildings.
- 5.1.3. Flags.
- 5.1.4. Calibration or Test Certificates
- 5.1.5. Items tested by certificated organisations.
- 5.1.6. Shall not be used in a misleading way.

Notes:

- 1. Notwithstanding the requirements contained in this document the AINDT and the AINDT Certification Board reserves the right to require those using the AINDT logo, or reference to AINDT in an unacceptable manner, to immediately desist and withdraw such documentation.
- 2. Where any doubt exists as to the correct usage of the AINDT logo or the AINDT name, advice should be sought from AINDT before using such marks.
